Work Schedule; Appointment Type: Full-time; Permanent. Multiple positions may be filled from this notice.

Responsibilities/Duties: Serves as a Chief, Design Branch.

- Serves as Chief, Design Branch in support of the Division Chief's design and engineering program. The Chief of Design Branch will provide authority on planning and design execution and will work with Section Chiefs to manage incoming work, to prioritize and assign existing work, and accomplish successful design and oversight of in-house projects. The Chief of Design Branch will provide executive steering to define Branch targets and goals, to improve quality of design functions, and to shape Branch growth and manpower planning.
- Through various supervisors, technical managers, team leaders, and Project Delivery Teams, manage
 design activities involving Army, Air Force, Navy, Marines, DoDDS, AAFES, NAF and other US Gov't and
 Host Nation funded projects in ROK. Directs a work force of professional and nonprofessional employees
 located in the Design Branch from grades GS/KGS-06 through GS/KGS-13 and retain accountability for the
 accomplishment of design, plans and specifications for the purpose of construction, operation, and
 maintenance of US and Host Nation funded projects in support of USFK.
- Exercises full supervisory control through subordinate supervisors responsible for guiding and controlling the work of a staff of employees. Responsible for establishing the organization, defining functional responsibilities, and delegating responsibilities to subordinates consistent with good management and administrative practices; and for coordinating the work of the various segments with the overall execution of the Branch functions.
- Through subordinate supervisors and technical managers, ensures timely performance of a satisfactory amount and quality of work, and has responsibility for reviewing, accepting, amending, or rejecting the work. With the section chiefs, establishes program schedules, sets priorities, and discusses related and coordinated work assignments affecting each section. Establishes internal policies and procedures to permit timely and effective performance of work.

Conditions of Employment:

- U.S. Citizenship required.
- This position requires the employee to obtain and maintain a Secret clearance.
- EMERGENCY ESSENTIAL STATEMENT: This position is considered essential to support the Army's mobilization and wartime mission during periods of increasing tension or mobilization.
- This position requires license as a Professional Engineer or Registered Architect at the time of appointment.
- Submit a Financial Disclosure Statement, OGE-450, upon entering the position and annually thereafter.

Travel Requirement: 10 % Temporary Duty Travel required

Education Requirements: Bachelor's degree (or higher degree) in engineering or architecture. This education must be

reflected on your resume and transcript(s).

Professional Registration or Licensure: Current registration as a Professional Engineer (PE) or Registered Architect (RA) by any State, the District of Columbia, Guam, or Puerto Rico required for GS-13 level.

<u>Relocation</u>: Permanent Change of Station (PCS) allowances may be authorized, subject to the provisions of the Joint Travel Regulations and an agency determination that a PCS move is in the Government Interest.

<u>Hiring Incentive</u>: Hiring incentives such as a recruitment/relocation incentive may be authorized (subject to available budget) if the selecting official determines the incentive is in the best interest of the government.
