Responsibilities/Duties: Responsible for reviewing, coordinating, monitoring, and providing interface with staff counterparts of various organizations.

- As the Government Negotiator, responsible for the execution of assigned AE pre-award projects.
- As members of Project Delivery Teams (PDTs), work with the team to ensure necessary information/documents have been acquired for the project initiation.
- Prepares TORNs (Task Order Requirement Notice) and conducts A-E selection based on the Architect-Engineer selection criteria.
- Performs the process of A-E design pre-award activities including preparation of Statements of Work (SOW), review and analysis of A-E design proposals, pre-negotiation and post-negotiation memorandums (POM, PNM).
- Perform negotiation with A-E representatives through face-to-face or virtual sessions
- Participates in procurement solicitation meetings; scope validation meetings, pre-proposal meetings, fact-finding meetings, and solves, advises and/or evaluates project pre-award issues.
